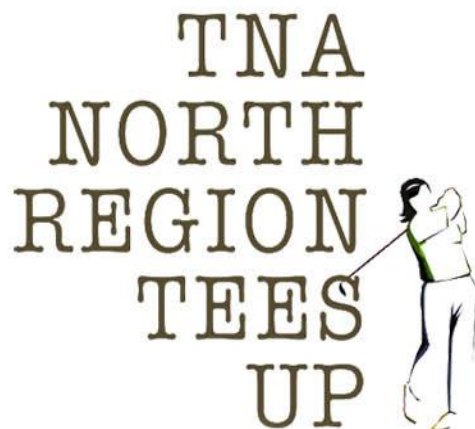

For \$15 per person, non-golfers may also attend the dinner and receive one ticket toward a possible door prize. Bar-B-Q gala is 5:30-7:30 p.m.
