

Resolution on Decision Making Models for Education

Adopted by the Texas Nurses Association House of Delegates, April 25, 2009

WHEREAS, nursing education in Texas is in the midst of innovative changes; and

WHEREAS, nursing education will function in new and different pathways to meet Texas' increased demand for RNs; and

WHEREAS, it is a time for ethical decisions, professional content decisions and education operational decisions to be made; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Texas Nurses Association engage its colleagues from all aspects of nursing education and practice in a discussion to design the most effective policy decision making body; and

RESOLVED, that the TNA Board of Directors report back to 2010 House of Delegates on the results of such discussion and provide a model for policy decisions on nursing education.
